Eligibility Requirements and Disclaimers

Individuals seeking a service dog must completely meet the following requirements:

- Applicant must be at least 18 years of age and be able to handle the service dog independently
- Applicant must fully complete the application leaving no question unanswered
- Applicant must participate in at least one interview with the **Mid-South K9s For Veterans** team.
- Applicant must be able to proficiently handle the service dog and in a variety of public environment while managing the dog's safety, behavior, and working skills
- The **Mid-South K9s For Veterans** team can, at any time, reclaim the service dog if the dog has been mistreated, abused, neglected, and/or otherwise deemed that the needs of the dog have not been met. Also, service dogs can be reclaimed if the individual does not return phone calls and commit to trainer visits.
- Applicant must demonstrate a genuine need for the service dog.
- Applicant may require assistance from another person in order to maintain the health and grooming of the service dog.
- Applicant must provide food and annual vaccinations for the service dog.
- Applicant must attend all training sessions indicated and agreed upon at the time of placement.
